stained glass can be completely rebuilt using new lead came and solder, while still preserving the original design and glass.

The history of glass

Man made glass is more than 4,000 years old and is made up of silica, quartz and a stabilizer such as flint. Glass, as a material was most likely discovered by accident in ancient



Egypt. From there, it spread to the Mediterranean and then to Europe and the Middle East. The artistic forerunners to modern day stained glass are thought to be crowns set with jewels and mosaics, which are patterns, composed of many pieces of colored glass.



As leaded glass emerged, artisans discovered that they could crush the lead and make a paint that was then fired into the glass, creating details such as folds in clothing and facial features. This discovery

led to the installation of stained glass in churches to aid in passing on information to the masses.

The concept of light and spirituality is not new, and the magnificent windows in many of Europe's cathedrals attest to that. It must have been a mystical and awe inspiring experience walking into such extreme architecture and masses of colored light.



With the help of restoration and proper care, the stained glass of these structures has survived centuries of history. Beginning in France and Germany in the middle of the 20th century, stained glass panels have been experiencing a revival and their beauty can be found almost anywhere!
